Lesson 2, Part 2

Lesson title: What are the teachings of Bahá'u'lláh?

Relevant syllabus area: Theology, Key Stage 2, "What are the teachings of Bahá'u'lláh?"

Learning objective:

In this lesson, the children will learn more about the teachings of Bahá'u'lláh.

This lesson is done through a PowerPoint presentation and two activity worksheets.

Resources needed:

- Screen and computer on which to present the PowerPoint.
- Lesson 2, Part 2, Activity Worksheet. There is a different worksheet for KS2 Lower and KS2 Upper.

Estimated time for the lesson:

20 minutes.

Instructions:

1. The slide number is written on the top right of the screen.
2. Follow the corresponding narrative and directions for each slide. The narrative for the presenter is in quotes. Everything outside the quotes are directions for the presenter to follow.
3. After the presentation, instruct the children to complete the Activity Worksheet. Give them five to ten minutes to complete it. Then, ask the children to share what they chose as the most important teaching and why.
4. For Upper KS2, ask the children if they disagreed with any of the teachings and why. Also, ask them if they can think of any other ideas to create a safe and happy world.

Introduction: "In this lesson, we are going to learn more about the teachings of Bahá'ú'lláh, the founder of the Bahá'í Faith."

Introduction: "Bahá'u'lláh has many teachings to help create a happier and more peaceful world. Here are some examples." Proceed to the next slide.

A world language: "Bahá'ú'lláh said to create a world language so we can all understand one another no matter where in the world we live." Next slide.

A world police force: "To create a world police force, instead of every country having big armies." Proceed to the next slide.

A world currency: "To have a world currency, so we can buy and sell things easily." Proceed to the next slide.

A world system of law and justice: "To have a world system of law and justice, so criminals cannot escape." Proceed to the next slide.

End poverty in the world: "To take care of every person, so no one is ever hungry or homeless." Next slide.

Education for all: "That every child in the world should be able to go to school." Proceed to the next slide.

The equality of women and men: "Men and women should be treated equally. For example, they should be paid the same for doing the same job." Proceed to the next slide.

Eliminate prejudice: "Treat everyone fairly regardless of their race, religion, nationality, or ability. Include everyone!" Proceed to the next slide.

Bahá'í writing: "May all your intentions center in the welfare of humanity." Proceed to the next slide.

Explanation of the writing: "This means to be considerate of everyone in the world in all our actions."
